Subject : Draft Framework Decision on the retention of data processed and stored in connection with the provision of publicly available electronic communications services or data on public communications networks for the purpose of prevention, investigation, detection and prosecution of crime and criminal offences including terrorism.

Delegations will find attached a proposal by the Lithuanian delegation.

Article 2¹

Definitions

2. [Communication] data to be retained for the purpose set out in Article 1 include:
 1. Data necessary to trace and identify the source of electronic communication which includes – voice, video, SMS, EMS, MMS, VoIP, E-MAIL, FAX, PPP, POP3, SMTP, HTTP, HTTPS, FTP, ISS and other protocols, authorization data, subscriber name and surname, subscriber number, IP address, IMEI, IMSI and SIM numbers, prepay card number, top up card number, username, password, PIN and PUK codes. Subscriber contact information (agreement or other), subscriber service billing and payment information.
 2. Users initiating and receiving electronic communication, electronic communication service provider, transmitting equipment data, receiving equipment data, equipment identification code (MAC or other), geographical location of the transmitting, routing and receiving equipment during connection, duration, termination or break of electronic communication.
 3. Data necessary to identify the time and date and duration of electronic communication.
 4. Type of electronic communication service, name of service, method of service implementation, type of access, technology of provided service, method of access, legal and natural persons who maintain electronic communications service and equipment.
 5. Manufacturer of electronic communications device and equipment, description of electronic communications device and equipment (model, specification, version of operating system, serial number and so on), their purpose, methods of use.).
 6. Location of terminal equipment – for fixed lines: address, first communication point; for mobile communications: data of network cell (at start, duration and end of the communication), IMEI, IMSI geographic location; for internet: IP address, MAC address, location of installation, (IP) network address, first routing point and its location.
